Say no to postal deregulation



The federal government is conducting an inquiry into our public post office called the Canada Post Corporation Strategic Review. The government's review will look at basic questions: Should our public post office continue to have an exclusive privilege to handle letters so that it has enough money to provide universal postal service? Or should it be deregulated by allowing anyone to deliver letters without the obligation to provide service in rural areas? Postal deregulation in other countries has led to post office closures, less service, fewer jobs and higher postal rates for the public and small businesses. There is no good reason to make a change which would undermine Canada Post's ability to fund and provide service to everyone. We currently have one of the lowest postage rates in the industrial world. Our postal services are universal and affordable, no small feat in the second largest country in the world.

Hands off our post office – Help us say no to postal deregulation.
